

SIZE GUIDE

When deciding on what size table to purchase, here are some things to keep in mind:


Allow 2' per place setting
Allow 3' of clearance from all sides of your table to the nearest wall or piece of furniture




A 60" table can *comfortably* seat four, with one chair on each side and one on each end. Adding extra width will allow you to *snugly* seat six.




A 72" table can *comfortably* seat six, with two chairs on each side, straddling the base, and one chair on each end.




A 78" table is *ideal* for seating six. With two chairs fitting *comfortably* between the base on either side and one on each end, this length provides a *spacious* layout for a party of six.



An 84" long table gives you options. You can *comfortably* seat six to eight guests depending on your seating configuration. Swapping chairs for a **bench** on one or both sides might be helpful here.



A 96" table can seat eight *comfortably*, with three chairs on either side (two on each side straddling the base) and one on each end.



A 102" table is *ideal* for seating eight to ten guests. With six feet between the base, three chairs can fit *comfortably*. Straddling the base will allow you to add a fourth to each side.
